Scope:	This project shall change the record security view on the records (listed below in this FRD) to the security view recommended by Oracle that are used within EMPOWHR queries. Currently, records requiring a record security view are configured, by default, with a record security view that will retrieve only the current inheritable future dated actions when these records are used in a query. Changing this record security view will allow queries to retrieve all future dated actions including new hire future dated actions. Changing these records' security view (recommended by Oracle) will provide future dated actions and maintain the integrity of the records row level security.
